

Definition List: Chapter 19

Antinomian: The view that all Born Again Believers are freed from all moral obligations.

bema: Judgment seat of a Roman official. It is an elevated platform in which decisions were made from.

Judaizers: Radical Jewish Christians who believed that one must become a Jew before they can be born again. They did not agree with Paul's teachings.

Northern Galatian Theory: the view that Paul wrote to the church in Galatia while on his second missionary journey, in north-central Asia Minor.

Southern Galatian Theory: the view that Paul wrote to the church in Galatia while he was in Asia Minor, prior to meeting with the Jerusalem council.

Theologia crucis: (Greek term) Theology of the Cross. A way of understanding the gospel in reference to suffering, enduring and conquering through faith in Jesus Christ.

Theologia Gloriam: (Greek term) Theology of glory. Understanding the Gospel primarily as a means for betterment and the way to succeed.

Via Dolorosa: (Greek term) "The way, or path of suffering". Literally the path that Jesus took in Jerusalem, on the way to Golgotha.
