

## Sovereignty of God the Creator

Read [Psalm 24:1-3](#)

"The earth is the Lord's and all its fullness; the world and those who dwell therein" ([Psalms 24: 1-2](#)).

"For since the creation of the world God's invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that men are without excuse" (Rom 1:20). God created the plants. The psalmist exclaims, "Let the field be joyful, and all that is in it. Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice" (Ps 96:12). God created the earth: "I tell you that, if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out" ([Luke 19:40](#)). God created the sun, moon, and stars: "The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament shows His handiwork" (Ps 19:1). God created all creatures: "O Lord, how manifold are Your works! In wisdom, You have made them all; the earth is full of your possessions" (Ps 104:24).

The sovereign Creator doesn't need us, but He wants a personal and eternal relationship with us. That is why "I will sing unto the Lord as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being" (Ps 104:33). "For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised" ([Ps 96:4](#)).
