

## Sovereignty of God's Salvation

Read [Ephesians 2:8-9](#)

Sovereign means having ultimate power or authority. When Jesus speaks of salvation or about our eternal life in [John 14:6](#), He says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life". He speaks with authority and singularity. He does not say I am one of many truths—or ways! He is the only way! From this, we can end our search for reconciliation with God. We can rest in our assurance that salvation is finished through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Another Passage that speaks to this is Acts 4:12, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved. "There are no optional plans for salvation. 1 John 5:13 says, "These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God."
