No Attention Drawn to One's Actions

Read <u>Matthew 6</u>

Let's give God the glory in all things. Jesus spoke of people who practiced their righteousness to be seen and admired by others. Their focus was on themselves and what notoriety they might receive. All too often, we fall into the same trap if we are not careful. God alone should be the focus of our giving, praying, or fasting. Keep focused on the Great Commission—going and telling others about Jesus. He is to be the one we draw attention to not ourselves.

John the Baptist rightly said in John 3:30, "He must increase, but I must decrease." So in all things, let God be magnified in your life. Do not be arrogant or prideful, but let God be glorified in our words and actions. A godly giver never draws attention to self because his/her focus is on Christ.


