## **Results of One's** Faith in God

## Read Hebrews 11:6

"My God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in Christ Jesus" (Phil 4:19); "ask and it shall be given you" (Matt 7:7); if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us (<u>1 John 5:14</u>). These are three great verses about God our Giver. What about us? What words or actions describe our giving to God? In my life, giving has been a journey of faith—do I really trust God to do what He says He will do; is God faithful?

I learned early to tithe off my allowance. When I started working, I tithed off my salary. When I married and had a young family and things were unbearably tight, I learned to write my tithe amount in the checkbook right under the paycheck deposit before ever paying a single bill. Through each of these, I was building a foundation of trust in God's faithfulness to meet my needs-and He always did. He has never been selfish with His blessings to me or my family. And when at one point just a few years ago I was thinking of holding onto an unexpected blessing—He lovingly prompted me: "Don't you close your hand against me." And so I learned the blessing of an opened hand to God. When I hold my hand up to Him in supplication and keep it opened, it flows through my hand to bless not just me but others too.
